Hope Inspired Ministries helps alleviate poverty by providing workforce training and job placement through a relational approach, helping individuals find purpose and self sufficiency.

Founded in Montgomery, Alabama in 2012, HIM has grown steadily every year and now operates in eight locations across Alabama, including Birmingham, Bessemer at The Foundry Ministries, Cullman at The Foundry Farm, Lowndes County, Montgomery, and Mt. Meigs at the Department of Youth Services, the Montgomery County Detention Facility and in Brent, AL at the Bibb County Correctional Facility.

The HIM process is built on a nine-week job training program where students learn the skills necessary to be successful in a work environment. Students participate in six weeks of classroom instruction followed by a three-week internship with a local business, which often leads to full time employment with the intern provider.

Results from the HIM program in Montgomery demonstrate that even the most marginalized men and women can become self-supporting, productive members of the community. When personal dignity is restored and hopelessness removed, skills and values can be passed down to children and grandchildren and ultimately have a generational impact on society.
